Notification

G.S.R.--- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to the article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of Natural History Museum, Department of Science and Technology (Group 'A' and Group 'B' Posts) Recruitment Rules, 1975 in so far as they relate to the post of Taxidermist, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Taxidermist in the National Museum of Natural History, Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement.- (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change, National Museum of Natural History, Taxidermist Recruitment Rules, 2016.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of post, classification, pay band and grade pay or pay scale.- The number of the said post, its classification, pay band and grade pay or pay scale attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications, etc.- The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualification.- No Person.-

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax.- Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with Union Public Service Commission relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving.- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Schedule Castes, the Schedule Tribes, ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
