NMNH invite schools in Delhi-NCR to participate in this programme.

The details of the programme are as following:

Date: Tuesday, 16th September, 2014

Venue: Indira Paryavaran Bhawan Premises/NMNH

Participants: School students from Classes IX to XII (Delhi-NCR schools)

Information & Instructions for the schools:

- 1. Each school may send One Model in the competition on any one of the following themes:
- a) Ozone Layer Protection: the mission goes on
- b) Effects of Climate Change (Global Warming)
- c) Pollution and Life
- 2. The size of the model should be 24" x 24" x 12" (with cover)
- 3. There should not be more than Two students in the team for making the model.
- 4. All the entries must bear the Name of the students, Class, Age and School Address.
- 5. One Teacher co-coordinator may be deputed with the team of students.
- 6. School Principal's certificate is required certifying that the model is actually made by the students themselves. Without certificate model will not be part of exhibition and certificate must be presented at the time of model submission.

For preliminary selection of the models, the teams may send sketches/drawings of the models with a short note explaining the concept of the model by E-mail to the Division of Educational Services, NMNH latest by 4th September, 2014. Thirty best entries will be informed to prepare models by 10th September, 2014 through E-mail/telephone.

Thirty numbers of best models selected on the basis of sketches/drawings and concept notes by internal panel of Judges/Experts from NMNH will be exhibited at the venue (Indira Paryavaran Bhawan Premises) on 16th September, 2014 for final Judgment by a Panel of Judges/Experts nominated by NMNH.

Five winner Teams will be declared for First, Second, Third and Two Encouragement prizes. Each winner Team will receive cash prize, certificates and a Trophy on the occasion. Teacher coordinators and all the other participants will receive participation certificates. Ten best models will be exhibited in the museum.

The winner teams will be given prizes as following:

First Prize Rs.10,000/-Second Prize Rs.7,000/-Third Prize Rs.5,000/-

Two Encouragement Prizes of Rs.1,000/- each

Refreshment/working lunch will be provided to the participating students & teachers.

All entries of models will become the property of National Museum of Natural History, N. Delhi.
