Monthly Report for the month of August, 2014

Foot Falls- A total number of 39,706 public and school students visited NMNH and its Regional Centres during the month of August 2014.

NMNH, New Delhi organized “3-day Orientation Workshop” for Trainee Teachers from 27th to 29th August, 2014 for 40 trainee teachers with Science/Environmental Science background from International Women Polytechnic, Delhi.

Ten member delegations from the Parliamentary Committee on Museums of Nigeria’s House of Representatives visited NMNH on 7th August, 2014.

RMNH, Mysore organized a lecture with power point presentation during Teacher Training Workshop at Mysore ZOO on 22 July 2014 and a special guided tour was arranged for the graduates of Forest College, Ponnampet during their study visit on 9th August 2014. RMNH, Mysore and Mysore Science Foundation (MSF) has jointly organized a programme “Interaction with Scientist” on 17-08-2014. MSF and RMNH, Mysore jointly arranged Nature Poem Recitation Competition on 10-08-2014. RMNH Mysore has emerged as first Indian museum to have Audio loop Assistive device for museum visitors with hearing impairment which would make their museum visit worthy.

RMNH, Bhopal observed “Second World Lion Day” on August 10, 2014 to create awareness about the conservation of lion especially the Asiatic Lion. Special interactive session was arranged for 150 participants of Post Graduate Diploma in Environmental Management (PGDEM) from Environmental Planning & Coordination Organization (EPCO), Bhopal on August 6th 2014.

RMNH, Bhubaneswar organized on the “Spot Painting Competition” in two categories for the student of class I to IV and Class V to VII on the topic “Rain” & “Van Mahotsav” and also organized “Written Quiz Competition” in four categories for the student of class VIII to X, +2, +3 and PG to mark the 10th Foundation day on 3rd August 2014. All the winners of the various competitions (on the spot painting and written quiz) were awarded with prizes & certificates on the occasion of Foundation Day of the museum on 10th August, 2014.

RGRMNH, Sawai Madhopur organized a short lecture on the topic “Role of the Natural History Museums in wildlife conservation in India” to members of District Chemist Association, Sawai Madhopur on 20th August 2014 and projected a documentary on Wildlife and Nature.
