Category I: Poem Writing Competition
 Category II: Essay Writing Competition

*The poems should be original and self made and written either in English or Hindi (not more than 20 lines).

Writing papers will be provided by the museum. The participants may bring their own writing board, pen/pencil and other stationery material, etc.

All the entries will the sole property of the museum and it will have the right to use it for any purpose it considers appropriate.

The evaluation of the poem and essay writing copies will be done by a panel of Judges nominated by NMNH.

The Prizes to be awarded in the two categories of competitions are:

First Prize worth Rs.3000/-, Second Prize worth Rs.2000/-, Third Prize worth Rs.1000/- and Five Encouragement Prizes worth Rs.500/- each. The prizes and certificates will be awarded during the Prize Distribution Function to be held on 31st May 2016 tentatively along with Valediction of Summer Vacation Programme-2016. All the winners will be informed accordingly.

Each school may send **10 numbers (5 participants in each category)** of interested participants to participate in the competitions to be held on **Friday, 22nd April, 2016 from 10:30 am to 12:30 pm in the museum premises.** The list of the participating students along with the teachers accompanying them may reach this office by **19th April, 2016 by 5:00 pm.** The registration is restricted to only 200 students on first come first served basis.
