Poster Making Competition on the occasion of Earth Day to select “Young Environmentalist of the Year Award-2015”

A National Level “**Poster Making Competition**” was organized on the occasion of Earth Day on 22nd April, 2015 for the children born between 1st April 1997 and 31st March 2001. The Global Earth Day 2015 Theme was – “It’s our turn to Lead”. The competition was held at NMNH, New Delhi and Regional Centres at Mysore, Bhubaneswar, Bhopal and Sawai Madhopur.

Entry was by Registration only which was done at each venue during 15-19 April 2015. Schools were asked to send their entries by 21st April 2015. Maximum of 200 children were allowed to register on first come first serve basis.

At NMNH, New Delhi 277 children from 36 schools in Delhi-NCR participated in the competition. Judgment of the entries of Poster Making Competition was done on 5th May, 2015 by a panel of Judges nominated by NMNH.

The best Regional Prize entry from each venue are be pooled to select One National Winner who will be given the “**Young Environmentalist of the Year Award-2015**” (YEYA-2015) at a function to be held in New Delhi on 5th June 2015 on the occasion of World Environment Day.

The Judgment of the best Regional entries from all the centres was done on 20th May, 2015 by a panel of Judges/experts at NMNH, New Delhi to select the national winner for “Young Environmentalist of the Year Award-2015”.

This year the national winner to get the “Young Environmentalist of the Year Award-2015” is SATABDI DEBADULARI, Class-IX, D.A. V. Public School, Chandrasekhar Pur, Bhubaneswar (Odisha).
