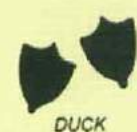

Go Wild for Life- ZERO TOLERANCE FOR ILLEGAL Wildlife TRADE

Celebrated globally on 5 June every year, the World Environment day (WED) highlights various conservation and environmental issues with a different theme every year.

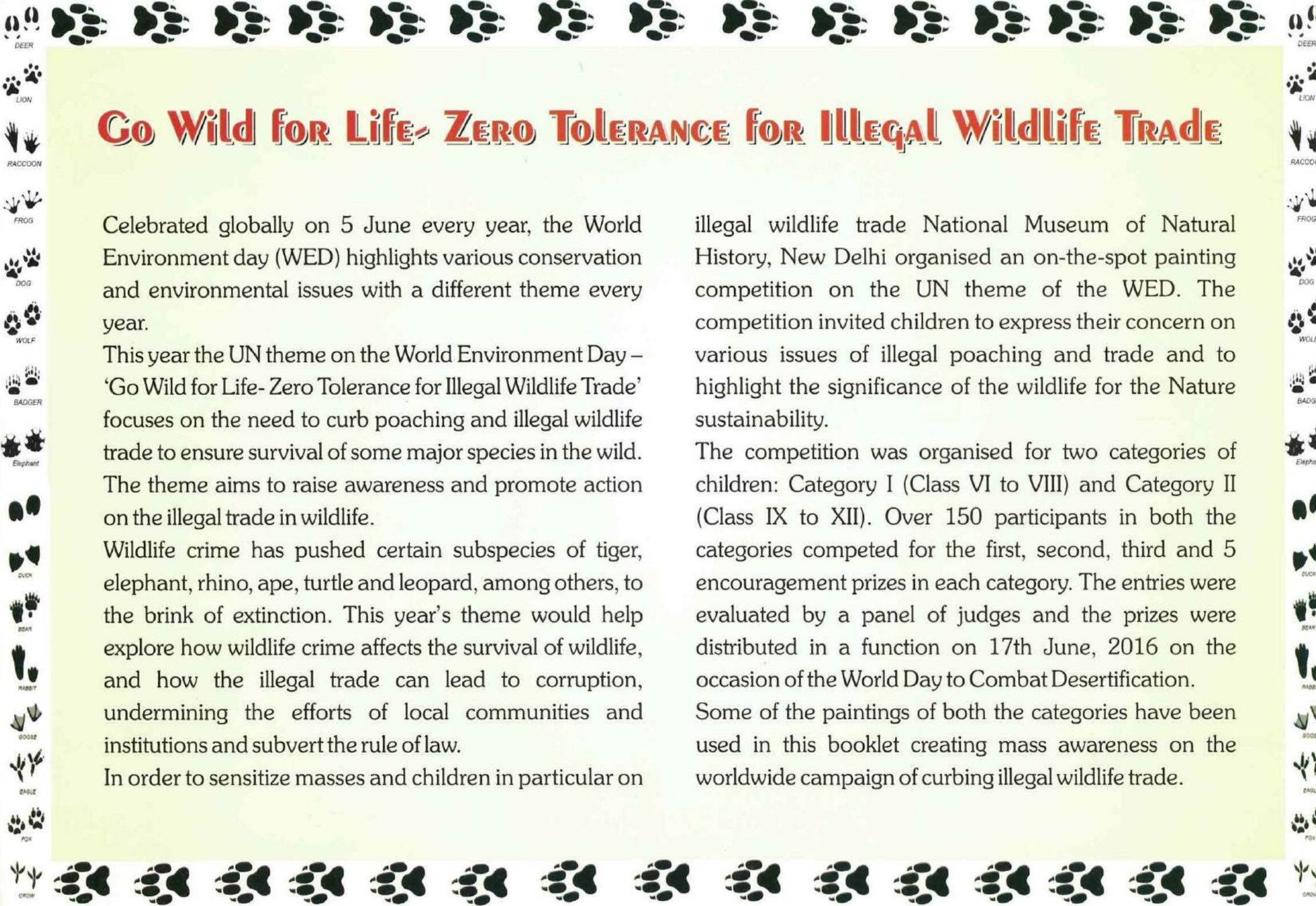
This year the UN theme on the World Environment Day – ‘Go Wild for Life- Zero Tolerance for Illegal Wildlife Trade’ focuses on the need to curb poaching and illegal wildlife trade to ensure survival of some major species in the wild. The theme aims to raise awareness and promote action on the illegal trade in wildlife.

Wildlife crime has pushed certain subspecies of tiger, elephant, rhino, ape, turtle and leopard, among others, to the brink of extinction. This year’s theme would help explore how wildlife crime affects the survival of wildlife, and how the illegal trade can lead to corruption, undermining the efforts of local communities and institutions and subvert the rule of law.

In order to sensitize masses and children in particular on

illegal wildlife trade National Museum of Natural History, New Delhi organised an on-the-spot painting competition on the UN theme of the WED. The competition invited children to express their concern on various issues of illegal poaching and trade and to highlight the significance of the wildlife for the Nature sustainability.

The competition was organised for two categories of children: Category I (Class VI to VIII) and Category II (Class IX to XII). Over 150 participants in both the categories competed for the first, second, third and 5 encouragement prizes in each category. The entries were evaluated by a panel of judges and the prizes were distributed in a function on 17th June, 2016 on the occasion of the World Day to Combat Desertification. Some of the paintings of both the categories have been used in this booklet creating mass awareness on the worldwide campaign of curbing illegal wildlife trade.
