Trees for the Earth

Signifying the importance of trees for sustenance of the living world, United Nations (UN) declared 22nd April as International Earth Day in 2009. The Earth Day was first observed way back in 1970. In fact, it was the Earth Day 1990 that paved the way for the 1992 United Nations Earth Summit in Rio de Janeiro.

The theme for the Earth Day 2016 is "Trees for the Earth". We are losing billions of trees on planet earth every year due to various anthropogenic activities. The need of hour is to conserve and protect trees for the sustenance of all living organisms, including combating of climate change and pollution significantly.

To mark the occasion of Earth Day 2016, a National Level Poster Making Competition for children for the selection of the Young Environmentalist of the Year Award (YEYA) - 2016 was organized by the National Museum of Natural History, Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, New Delhi. The competition invited the children to express their perceptions on the theme of the Earth Day through brush and paint to convincingly highlight the theme for sustainability of the living world, and reversal of the processes of land degradation and biodiversity loss.

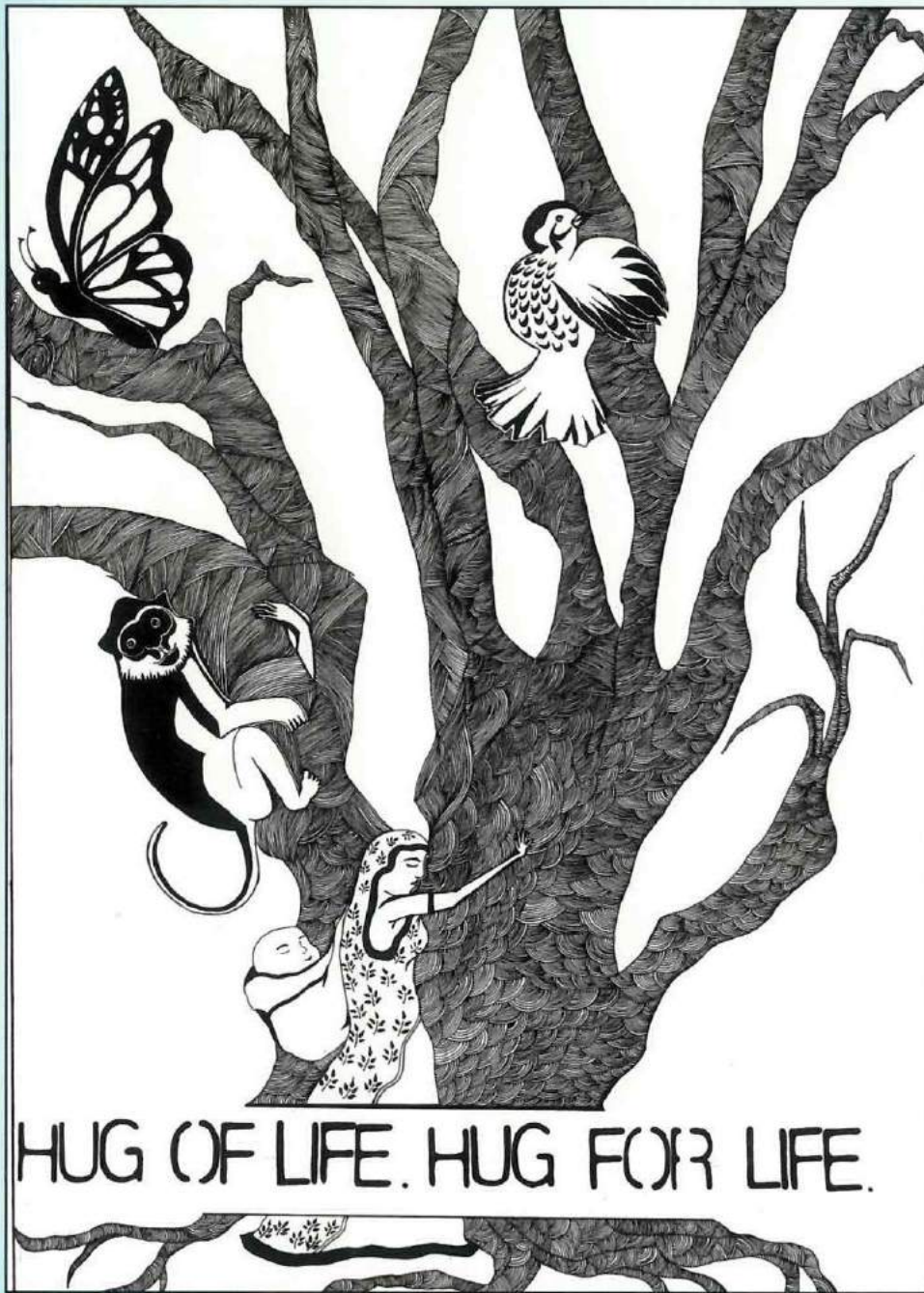
The entries received through the competition were evaluated by a panel of experts. Some of the selected entries have been used in this publication.
