National Museum of Natural History, New Delhi [NMNH]

National Museum of Natural History, launched an online Slogan writing competition (Pan India) for the students of 6 to 8 on the theme: "Only one Earth". All the eligible entries will be judged by the panel of judges to select the best six entries to award First, Second, Third and three encouragement prizes.

All the children were given token gifts in the form of books. Refreshments were also served to all participants.
