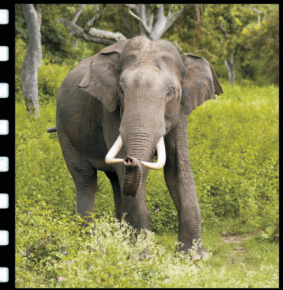

About RGRMNH

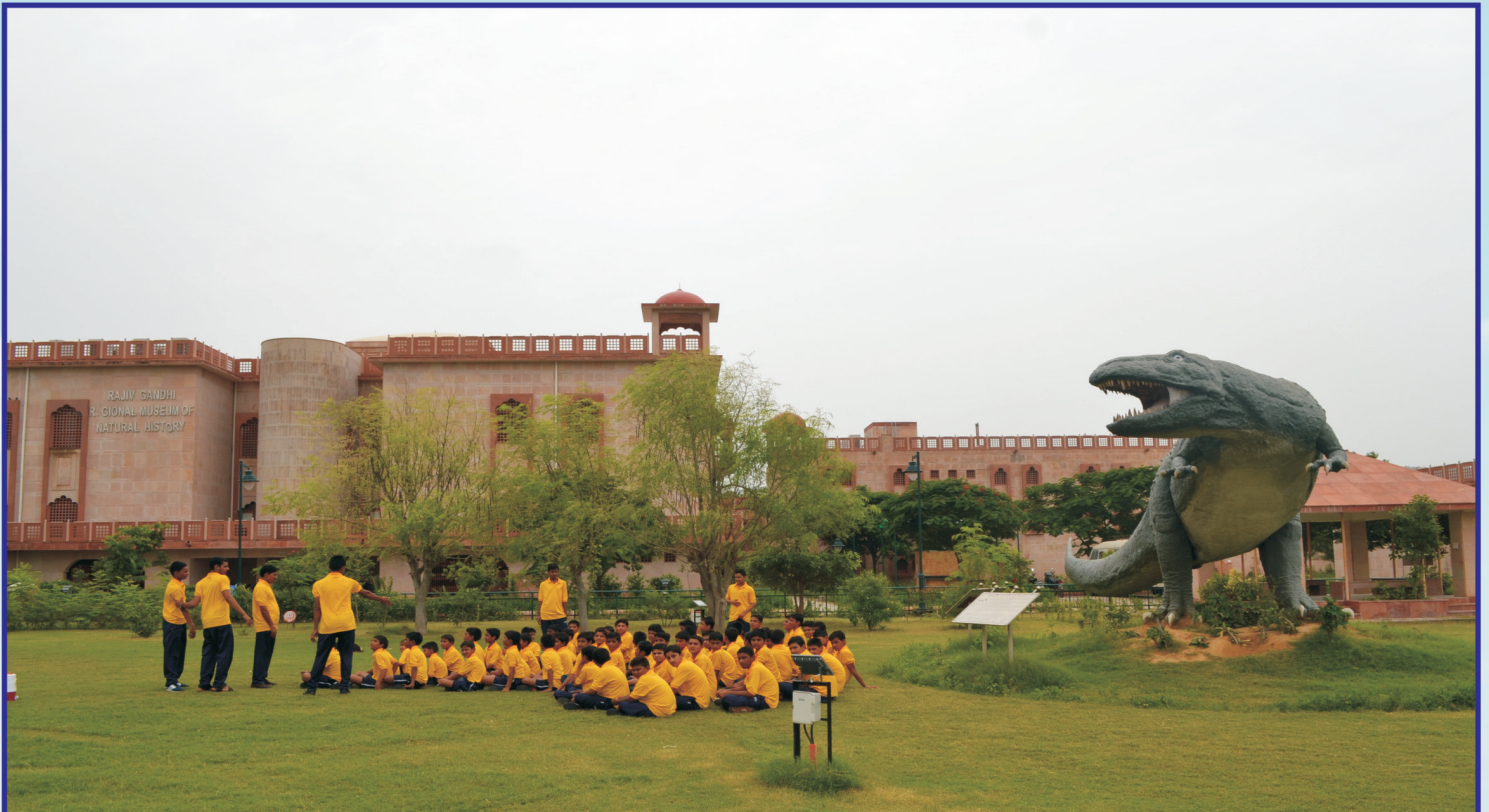

This institution is devoted to environment education among the different masses of the community. This museum has been opened to the general public from 01st March, 2014 with temporary galleries on - Biodiversity of Rajasthan, Biodiversity of Western Ghats, Flora & Fauna of RTR, corridor consisting different flora & fauna of India, Eco theatre, Auditorium, library & Reception -cum-cloak room. It has a meaningful vision for developing scientific temper in the society on environment and natural heritage of the country by education, training and awareness under the guidance of National Museum of Natural History, New Delhi. It has mission to realize the international standard by collecting, conserving, documenting, researching and exhibiting object representative of flora & fauna of the country and especially geographical region (Rajasthan, Gujarat and Daman & Diu (UT) through accessible environmental education, training and awareness for a socially included society.

At present there are five galleries and seven temporary exhibitions are running in the service of society along with Biodiversity Park, Medicinal Garden, Nakshtra Garden, Cactus Garden etc.

Our Mission

Promoting and supporting non-formal environmental education through exhibition, education and research. The main objectives in accomplishment of our mission are to

- develop exhibit depicting the flora, fauna and geology of the region.
- depict ecological relationship among plants and animals including man and emphasize the importance of conservation through exhibits and educational programmes.
- provide special exhibits and activities to enrich the school curriculum in biology, particularly on environmental aspects.
- develop appropriate educational programme for children adults and family groups to create environmental awareness.
- publish popular educational material useful for environmental education.
- develop appropriate institutional collaboration within and outside the state to promote environmental education.
- develop eventually a state-wide programme for environment education through activities at the district level.
- disseminate information on biodiversity, ecology, environment & conservation through exhibit galleries and educational programmes.

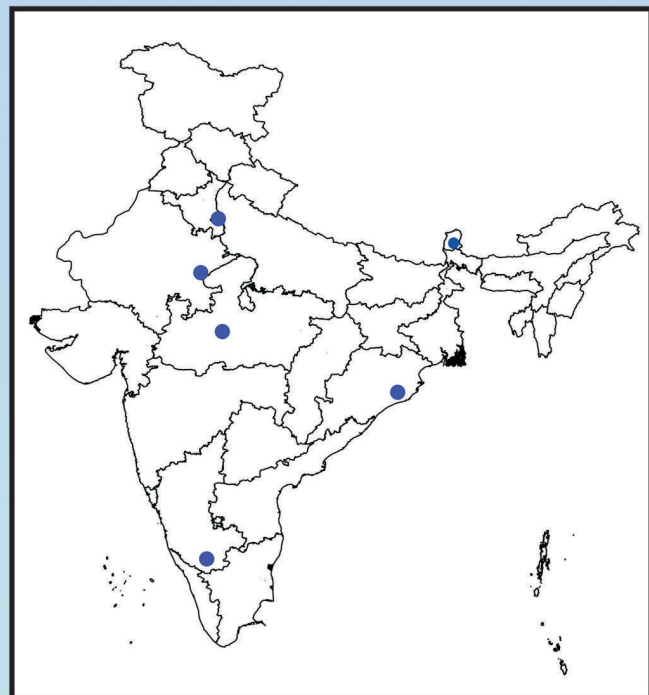
