- **Exhibition on Wheels** - a mobile museum for people who have a rare opportunity to visit museum.



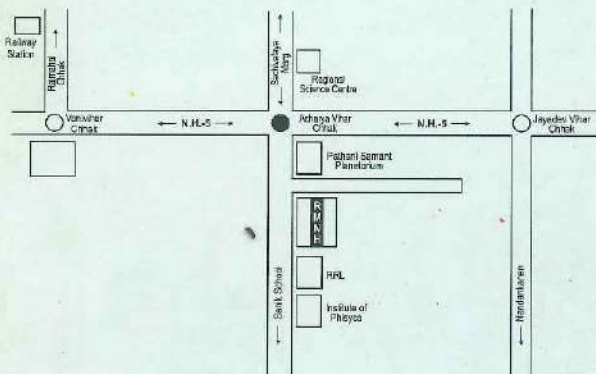
- **Nature on screen** (11.00 a.m. to 12.00 p.m.) - film shows, on nature & wildlife twice a day inside auditorium.

- Closed on all Mondays, Republic Day, Holi, Ratha Yatra, Independence Day, Gandhi Jayanti, Dussehra and Diwali.



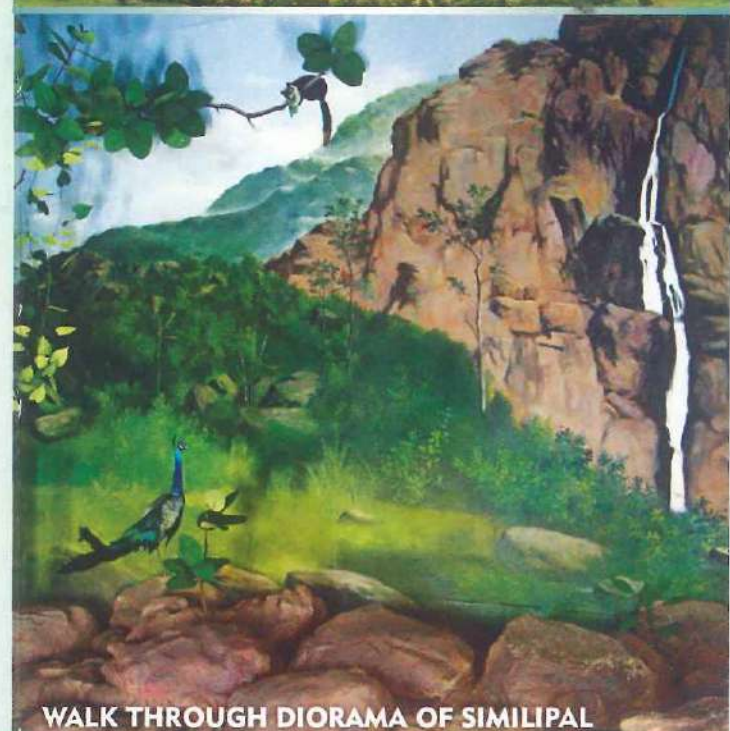
