RULES

1. Don't throw the wastage i.e. *paper, food, fruits peeling or wrappers* anywhere in the forest except in dustbin.
2. During NATURE – TRAIL, each and every student should have his/her own pen/pencil along with Notebook / Diary.
3. Never try to disturb any wild species in the forest i.e. may be plants or animals.
4. While watching from top to the ditch, never go to the edge because it may break.
5. Never touch any insect or anything in the forest, without telling your instructor, because it may be Poisonous/ harmful.
6. Don't make noise on Nature trail.
7. Wear shoes and tie up the laces during Nature walk.
8. Clutch each other's hands strongly during going down into the ditch or coming up from the ditch.
9. Ask frankly any question if you have any doubt.
